

8. Festival of Light, Tihar

In October 21-25, 2014 Tihar, a five-day-long festival, was celebrated in Nepal which comes soon after Dashain. Similar to Deepawali but with a regional variation. Tihar in general signifies the festival of lights, where diyas(light) are lit both inside the houses to make it illuminated at night. The five-day festival is considered to be of great importance as it shows reverence to not just the humans and the gods, but also to the animals like crow, cow and dog who maintain an intense relationship with the humans.

8.2.Bhai Tika

The fifth and the last day of Tihar is Bhai Tika, where sisters put seven colors tika on the foreheads of brothers, to bless the long life security, and thank them for theprotection they give. It is believed that Yamraj, the God of Death visited his sister Yamuna on this particular day. Where she applied the auspicious tika on his forehead, garlanded him and fed him with special dishes. Together, they ate the sweets, talked and enjoyed themselves to their heart's content. While parting Yamraj gave her a special gift as a token of his love and in return Yami also gave him a lovely gift which she had made with her own hands. That day Yamraj announced that anyone who receives tilak from his sister will never be thrown to death on that day. A special garland is made for the brothers out of a flower that wilts only after a couple of months, symbolizing the sister's prayer for her brother's long life. Brothers sit on a floor while sisters perform their puja. The puja follows a traditional ritual in which sisters circle

brothers dripping oil on the floor from a copper pitcher applying oil in brother's hair, then 7 color tika is applied on brothers forehead. Then brothers give tika to sisters in the same fashion along with exchange of gifts. This is practiced regardless of whether brother is younger or elder to the sister. Those without a sister or brother join relatives or friends for tika. This festival brings close relationship between brothers and sisters.

Similarly our girls put the seven colors tika on the forehead of their brother. They were extremely happy to celebrate this festival. Girls who have their own brother, she put to her own brother and girls who didn't have put for new brother. Likely, Ashmita put tika to his brother Kamal and Ashish and Bhumika put tika to Bidek. They exchanged gifts each other. Some of the volunteers had also made brothers and sisters from Rainbow family. This time, we had Australian, Spanish, England and Switzerland volunteers in Bhai Tika.

Rainbow big girls got one more opportunity to put tika to the guests of Butterfly Foundation and Western Hotel Association Pokhara. The guests were from USA, Australia, Norway, China, Switzerland, Germany and other countries. The guests were fascinated by the culture of Nepalese. Our children had played Deusi Bhailo with them.





