Background:

Saran brought to Rainbow Children Home on 24th of January, 2018. He was living inside the prison (Jail) with her mother. His mother married to a man who has already a wife. According to the Nepalese law order, if a women married with a man who had already a wife is a crime. And both (Husband and new wife) should be punished. Saran's mother married with a man who already had a wife so his father and mother both were punished by the government and put them in a prison (Jail), His father punished was punished a year ago. Now he out of prision and out of contact. Till this date we have not get any information about his father. No one knows where he is, So Saran was staying with his mother in the Jail. Her mother is Magar caste system and her husband is BK (the lower caste) according to the caste hierarchy system in Nepal. So Saran's mother's family do not accept his mother because she got married with a lower caste man. They said that she can enter the home withour saran, how could she left saran alone. We heard this information from the jailor, We usualy organize handicraft training inside the jail, during that time we got this information, after we hear this incident, we were trying to bring Saran to RCH. After doing lots of process we were able to bring him to RCH home. We talked with the jailer and bring Saran to Rainbow Children Home. He wants to study and go to school, so we are searching for a sponsor for him.

Deepshika and Deepson are brother and sister. They were both brought to Rainbow Children Home by District Children welfare committee in May, 2018. Their father left home and is still unknown where he is now not even he is alive or death. And after his father lost, their mother also married with other man and went to another village. So they stayed with their grandmother who is very old and cannot do anything. Some people took them to District Children welfare office for rescue the children because their grandmother cannot send them to the school and cannot give them food to eat. The District Children welfare committee brought these children to our home. Now we are looking help and support for them.

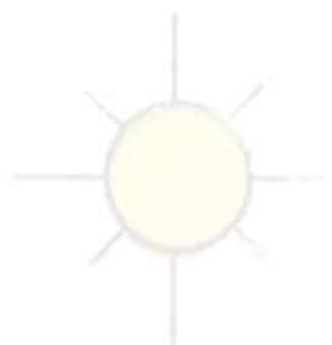
